ance.







AVONTUUR VAN 'N VROUT



Seamless Pattern Fabric Printing

Seamless patterns are motifs on fabrics that will continue to be continuous, and this technique is beneficial when we want to make motifs on huge fabric sizes. In making this pattern, I used two tools, and there are Adobe Illustration and Adobe Photoshop. I started by following the framework of an object that inspires, coloring, and arranges it into one. Because I like watching animated films, that's why I chose two animated films to be my inspiration, namely Rio 2 and Moana. These two animated films have diverse characters and show more of nature, which makes the audience feel free and entertained by the animation players' behavior. I made four different types of seamless patterns, two seamless patterns from each of the animated films. I apply it as a motif of bags and heels.
