
# Tips for a Successful Portfolio Account


1. PROFILE: Here is where you put all the information about you: your picture (or your logo), your field of study, contact information (email, website, LinkedIn, Instagram and Facebook links), hobbies, and even a short biography.

This section is important because it shows your personality and provides potential employers with their first impression of you, after which they can access more information about your work if they are interested.

To add or edit information, click on the **modify** button on the top left of your profile.

#### 2. ADD A NEW PROJECT:


To add a project you must complete the following steps:


- a Add a title to your project.
- b In this section, you can explain more about it, what tools and software you used and what was your inspiration and goal for it.
- c Cover Image (see C.1) is the big picture on top when you open the project.
- d Thumbnail (see C.2) is the small picture on the main page of your profile.
- You have the option to add other classmates for group projects.
- f You can add media to your project: images, videos, or documents. You can add up to 20 media items per projects.
- g You can mention other people who don't have an LCI Portfolio account.
- h Make sure you click
  "Publish", otherwise your
  project won't be visible.
- i Censored Project if your project contains sensitive material, you should click this option. The thumbnail will be hidden.
- j Click "Save" and your project will be displayed in your main page

**3. PROJECTS:** You can display up to 20 projects. It is recommended that you upload projects that you have received good feedback and you are proud of. Remember, you can always come back and update projects as you progress. The more projects in this section, the better impression employers will have about you.

If you were an employer, which profile/candidate would you be interested to call for an interview?






#### **PROFILE A**

Also, their projects have nice/captivating thumbnails and a variety were uploaded.



## 4. CURRICULUM VITAE (RESUMÉ):

To customize this section, click **Modify**:

- a You can add your skills, experiences, education and honors/awards so it's easily displayed.
- b You also have the option of uploading your resume (it is recommended to upload a PDF). Remember to always keep your resume updated.
