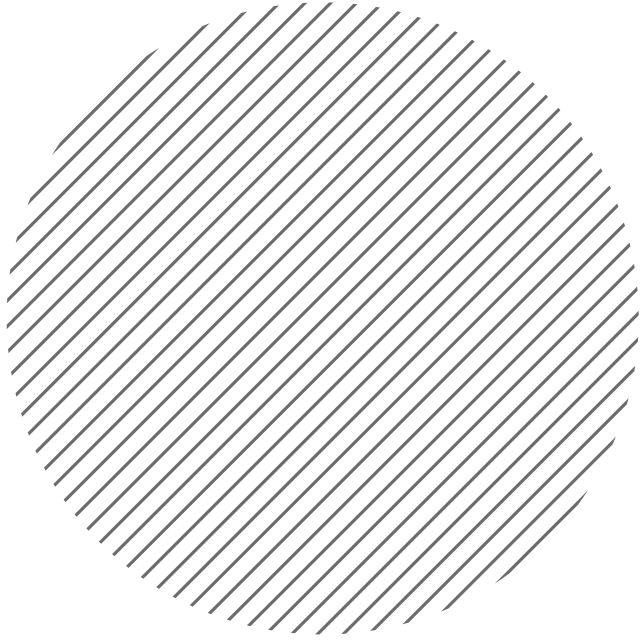

KEBAYA

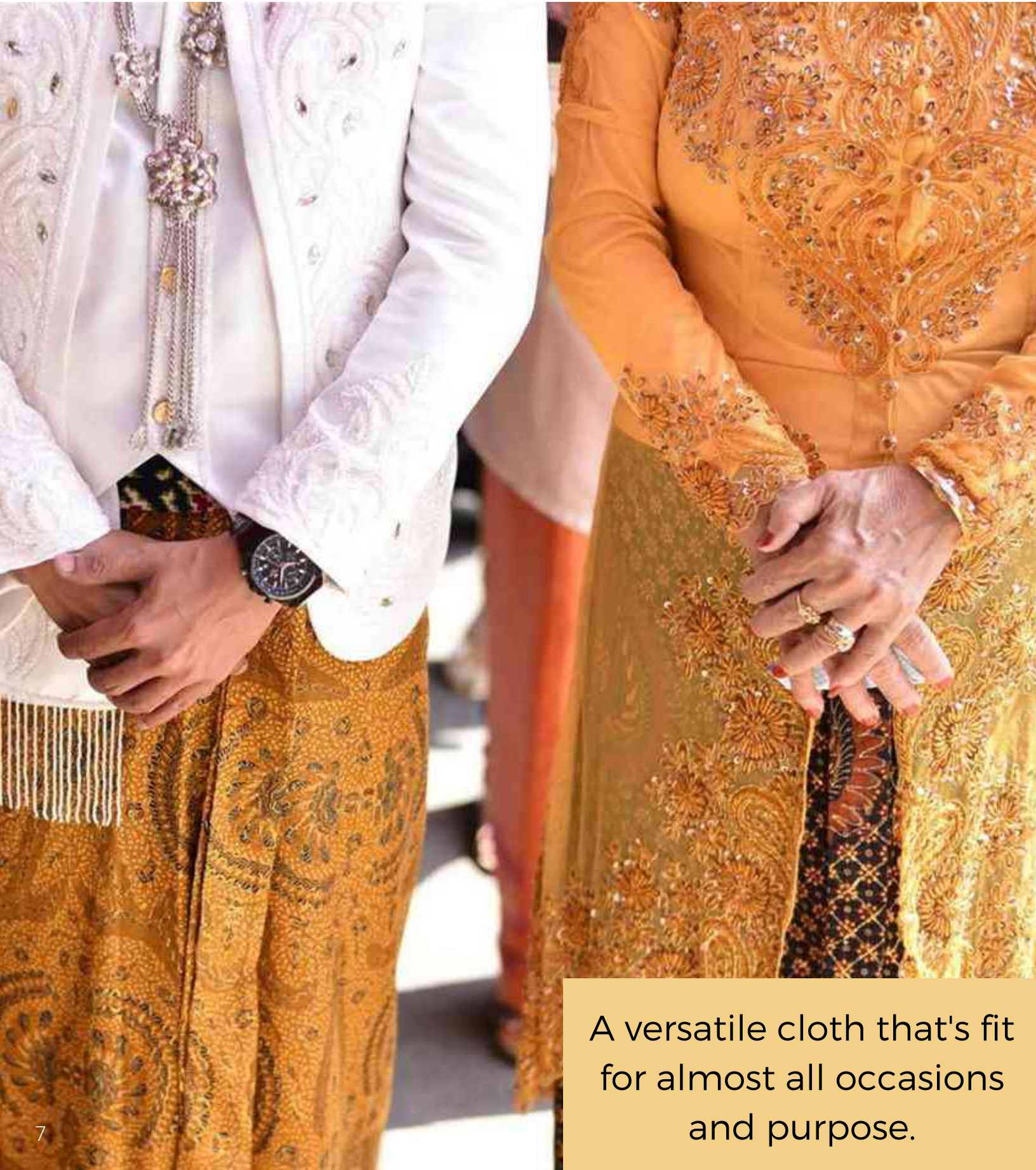

S U N T I A N G

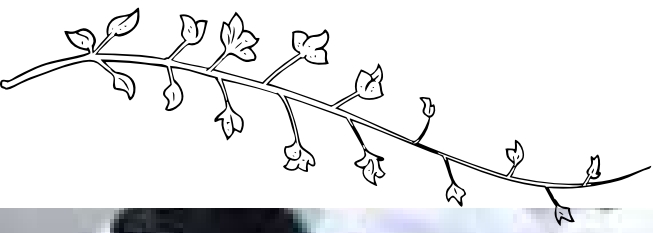

Originated and developed in Batak, North Sumatra, this handwoven fabric is used for ceremonial purposes. Usually worn as a shawl, ulos have a significant cultural value.



U D E N G



Udeng is a headdress worn by balinese men on a day-to-day basis. It is a form respect for their culture and beliefs.
