Inspiration

I was inspired by Rococo paintings on the roof and walls of the building from the Ballroom ceiling of the Ca Rezzonico. In the Rococo style, walls, ceilings, and moldings were decorated with delicate interlacings of curves and countercurves based on the fundamental shapes of the 'C' and the 'S' as well as with shell forms and other natural shapes. Asymmetrical design was the rule. Light pastels, ivory white, and gold were the predominant colours, and Rococo decorators frequently used mirrors to enhance the sense of open space. Paintings are usually depicted on walls or roofs, and cement carvings were applied to large poles supporting the building. I put all the characters in my design.

Painting was an essential part of the Rococo movement in France, influenced all elements of design from interiors to tapestries to fashion. That's why my overall design is a painting on fabric.




Inspiration

I was inspired by Barong Ket which came from Bali. Barong ket is one barong as a protector. The Barong character itself is a mythological creature in Hinduism. It is a symbol of virtue or dharma. Etymologically, the word Barong is believed to originate from Sanskrit which is the word b (h) arwang which in Malay and Indonesian parallels the word 'bear'. That refers to forest guardian animals. I will put inspiration in the colors and lack of barong myself in my designs.

My concept that takes the theme of Balinese culture with inspiration Barong Ket called Barong Protector. With the couture technique, I took details of the motifs from the barong ket carvings that I was going to embroider on and I was beading on the embroideries. the color of the barong like gold which dominates from the barong color and the red element has become the color palette in my collection.







Inspiration

Big Ben Tower with a four-faced clock made of about 312 glass opals and 1248 pieces of glass which is a famous icon in London precisely in the city of Westminster. Inspired by Big Ben because of its Neo-Gothic architectural style and geometric lines found in the details of the building. The design of the center of the clock that looks like a crystal shape. This Buildings made of brick covered with stone cladding.

My Collection uses the concept of a "blue collar" with my inspiration of the Big Ben tower in London. Display modes that represent several professions with the 'Hustler'. The design this fashion with various silhouette from large size pieces such as jacket, shirt and baggy pants. I also added many ornaments such as embroidery, hand stitch and laser cut. Cargo bag details to embossed pockets. I use a combination of bleach blue denim with an oyster yellow color taken from the Big Ben Tower. Sporty fashion style became my design line, to prioritize comfort in various activities. To give the impression of a luxurious, I combined denim with linen, taslan parachut and net fabric. A touch of detail in my collection makes a young impression that is 'intricately packed yet sophisticated'.


Inspiration

This collection is sustainable because of used fabric, using upcycling and zero waste techniques. It prevents the unsustainable usage of extracting materials from the Earth by making use of what has already been used (i.e. upcycling). Upcycling aims at the development of products truly sustainable, affordable, innovative and creative. Like a party dress that is old or unused, and even then it can be used as the main ingredient of fabric that is cut and re-sewn. The boards in the party shirt can be removed and used as embellishment in my collection.

The concept of this project is Sustainable with a loose baggy look. This collection is suitable for a woman. In this Collection, it uses Emerald green, Fire Yellow, Red Wine, Blue colors because my color like building of Flavorous Orchard, which is the color with shades of wood and the garden beside it. It chose silk fabric for this collection, it makes the outfit look good with in shape of building, but it uses sheer fabric to decorate all embellishment and fabric manipulation. For fabric manipulation, it uses buttons that are not used and the remaining fabric from the pieces.




Inspiration
