Cupro fabric is recycled, which appeals to our environmentally-minded sensibilities



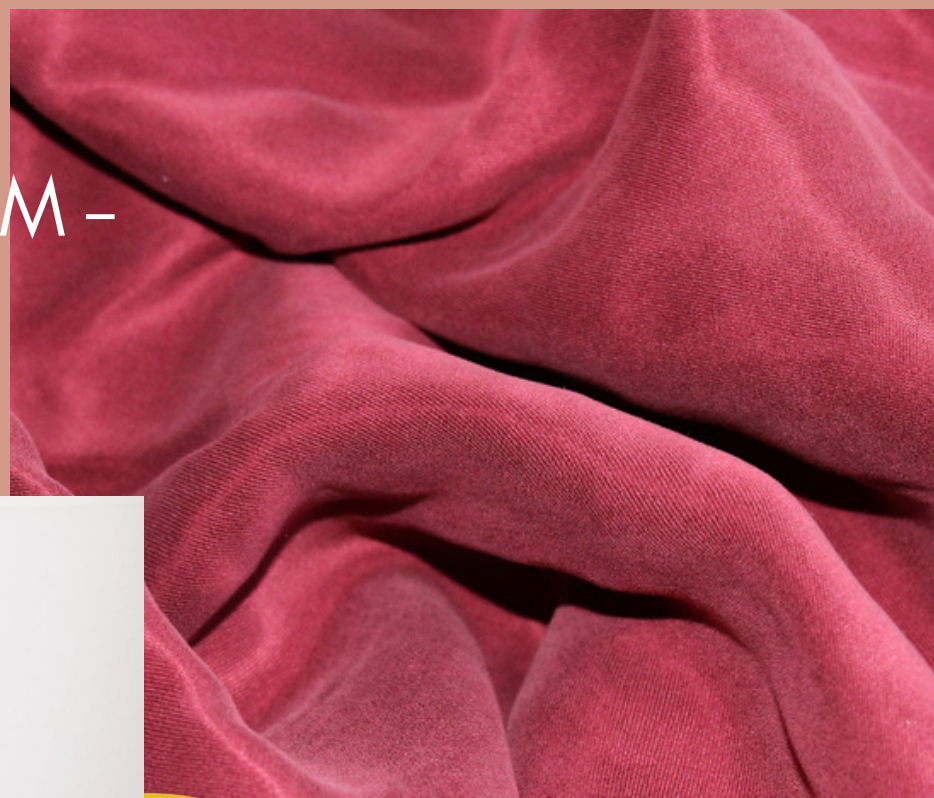

ADVANTAGES

- The fabric is breathable and regulates body temperature well
- no need to take this textile to the cleaners- it can be washed and dried in the machine
- anti-static, and resists stretching out at high temperatures
- hypoallergenic



DISADVANTAGES

- Ignites easily at temperatures above 180 degrees
 - Chars when ignited
- Leaves behind a residue containing significant concentrations of copper
